Drug Interactions

Mucosa compositum is not known to interact with any other medication. Mucosa compositum is often administered together with other homoeopathic medications or even with allopathic drugs.

Recommended dosage

Adults and children 12 years and over: Dissolve 1 tablet in the mouth 3 times daily.

Children 6 to 11 years: Give 1 tablet 2 times daily.

Children 2 to 5 years: Give half a tablet 3 times daily.

Gastric reinoculation

Mucosa compositum is a valuable adjuvant to probiotics.

Indications: Helps maintain healthy mucous membrane function. For the symptomatic relief of rhinitis. Relief of the pain and burning sensation associated with cystitis. Maintenance of healthy eyes. Provides relief from superficial eye problems such as sore, red and inflamed eyes. Relief of the symptoms, pain and discomfort of gastritis. Relief of symptoms of mild upper respiratory infections.

Therapeutic information: A treatment for all gastrointestinal complaints resulting from mucous membrane dysfunction. Also suitable for respiratory catarrh, sinusitis and laryngitis.

Prescribing methods: Useful in combination with Spascupreel and Nux vomica-Homaccord for gastrointestinal conditions with pain, spasm, and underactivity. Used with Luffa compositum and Bronchalis Heel for upper respiratory symptoms. Prescribed as an intermediary medicine during chronic treatment of disease states.

Convincing results

In a prospective cohort study, 830 patients were treated for various types of mucositis such as conjunctivitis and inflammations of the respiratory, gastrointestinal and genitourinary tracts. Half the cases treated were chronic. Mucosa compositum was administered as monotherapy to one third of the patients, with therapeutic results rated 'very good' or 'good' in almost 90% of these cases. Overall therapeutic efficacy was rated 'very good' or 'good' in 85.6% of patients receiving monotherapy or combination therapy (see illustration).¹⁾
